He is particularly critical of alternative medicine, and of the decision of a number of UK universities to offer degrees in complementary and alternative medicine, stating that they are "anti-science" and that "universities that run them should be ashamed of themselves." campaign, requiring the University of Central Lancashire to release details of their BSc course in homeopathy.
